THE COLLEGE OF EMERGENCY MEDICINE ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTIONS - 2009

At the Annual General Meeting of The College of Emergency Medicine held in Dublin on Wednesday 24th September 2008, it was confirmed that annual subscriptions to the College, with effect from **1st January 2009**, will be as follows:-

NB: Unless overseas, the membership rates cover UK and ROI.

*** These membership categories do not receive the EMJ unless specifically requested. If you require the EMJ there is an additional fee of £70 (€95) per annum.**

Fellows, Associate Fellows and Members with an annual income of less than £25,000 are eligible for a 50% reduction in subscriptions. Please contact the College office for details.

May I remind you that the College has been approved by the Board of Inland Revenue under Section 201 Income and Corporation Taxes Act 1968, which means that members' annual subscriptions are eligible for Income Tax relief.

I am pleased to inform you that over 95% of you now pay by Direct Debit, but if you do not already pay by Direct Debit and you have a UK bank account, would you please consider doing so. This would prove advantageous not only to you, but also to the College's administrative office. Forms are available from the College office.

For those members without a UK bank, or who would prefer to pay by cheque, please ensure that you forward your remittance (€Euros or £STERLING) (payable to 'The College of Emergency Medicine') to reach this office, by **no later than** 28th February 2009. You may prefer to pay via internet banking or by credit card (a 3% surcharge will be applied to payments made by credit card). Please contact the CEM office for our account details.
